

Mushroom, Wine and Whiskey Train





Call 707-964-5674 or visit http://calfire.ca.gov and look for the Mushroom Permit link. Maps, applications and FAQs can also be found on the website. **PLEASE NOTE:** It is illegal to forage in State Parks and violations can be punishable with fines up to \$1,000.
