WHERE CAN I FORAGE? Many folks have their secret spots in the County, either on private property or at a resort that allows guests to hunt for mushrooms. We recommend you forage with a guide or join one of the many guided walks offered during the festival. Make sure to pick up a permit (\$20) to forage in Jackson State Demonstration Forest. Call 707.964.5674 or visit <http://calfire.ca.gov> and look for the Mushroom Permit link. Maps, applications and FAQs can also be found on the website. PLEASE NOTE: It is illegal to forage in State Parks and violations can be punishable with fines up to \$1,000.


