Point Arena-Stornetta **Public Lands**

Daily until Sunset

View the lighthouse from the ground while hiking the over two miles of coastline, the estuary of the Garcia River and adjacent beach, and a small island accessible during low tide that are part of the Stornetta Public Lands. Watch for whales from the breathtaking headlands, wander through ocean mounds, islands, peninsulas, caves, blowholes, and take in the "infinity pool" waterfall that plunges into the ocean. Daytime activities include hiking, picnicking, nature photography, and wildlife watching.
